

It has been agreed that we continue fund raising for the Club with keeping the Lottery draw going through the closed season. To hopefully have winners more frequently we will now use the Wednesday and Saturday Lottery draws to do this. I set out below how this would work.

- 1) Choose six numbers between 1 and 49 and these will be checked against each Wednesday and Saturday lottery draw (not including the bonus ball) and the first to clear all six numbers will be the winner.
- 2) No two lines to be the same. The first person to give me a set of numbers will keep them and the other person will need to change.
- 3) In the event of a draw the prize monies will be split equally.
- 4) A new game will start once a line has been completed.
- 5) Cost will be 50p per week (i.e. 25p for the Wednesday draw and 25p for the Saturday draw) per line with 25p going to Club funds and 25p going to the prize fund.
- 6) E.g. If 40 members bought a line and after 6 draws a game was won – then £60 would be collected and £30 would go to the Club funds and £30 to the winner.

If anyone wants to join please let me have their numbers or tell me they want to keep the numbers they already have by either e-mail (e-mail: babsburton@talktalk.net) or post them to me at: 8 Stanley Close, Yarnton, Oxford, Oxfordshire, OX5 1UN. The draw started on Wednesday 30th September so you would be able to join at the commencement of a new game. I will advise you of the amount to pay. The monies will be collected in one go rather than weekly. If the last date for the draw is Wednesday 21st April 2010 that is 29 weeks which would cost £14.50 per person.

We hope as many bowls members as possible will participate. During the summer we had 36 members join with 4 members winning £20.25 each, 1 winning £81 and 1 winning £45.
